Site C - Clean Energy Project on the Peace River

The Site C Clean Energy Project is the third proposed dam on the Peace River in northeast B.C. The dam is projected to be a source of clean and renewable energy for over 100 years, producing enough electricity to power approximately 410,000 homes per year. It is part of BC Hydro's overall program to invest in and renew the province's electricity system through reliable sources of clean electricity and contributions to our goals of electricity self-sufficiency.
